6 Activities Report



Rural Show Coopavel. Cascavel / PR.

In order to make producers aware of the harms of Seed Piracy, ABRASEM — Brazilian Seed and Seed-lings Association and its Associates launched a campaign of national impact, related to this huge problem, which is the illegal production and marketing of non regulated seeds. The campaign first run was at the COOPAVEL Rural Show, one of the biggest events in Brazilian agribusiness, and its slogan is "Illegal Seeds Impact Productivity".

Visibility, impact and interaction will be the strengths of the campaign, which will lead as principles the main risks that the use of illegal seeds bring to Brazilian agribusiness, such as diseases, low productivity, tax evasion and non-remuneration of research. Because of the Campaign launch, APASEM — Paraná Association of Seed Producers, associated with the ABRASEM System, organized the event "The Challenges of Seed Production in Brazil", which featured presentations by representatives of ABRASEM, Ministry of Agriculture, Federal Highway Police and ADAPAR-PR

ABRASEM Workshop about Experimental Materials Registration, Pre Trade and Seed Lines. São Paulo / SP.

Considering the need to adjust the procedures for declaring genetic seed production among all MAPA units, through the SIGEF Supervisory Management System, and seeking full compliance with Legislation and equitable conditions for seed producers, in all Federation Units, DFIA / CSM found it essential to enable the registration of experimental or pre-commercial materials to allow the production of "genetic category" seeds.

In order to enable the registration of these experimental / pre-commercial materials in the RNC, this type of registration was included in the RNC database through the category "EXPERIMENTAL / PRE-COMMERCIAL MATERIAL", associated with the observation "ONLY FOR THE PRODUCTION OF SEEDS OF THE GENETIC CATEGORY. THE PRODUCTION AND MARKETING OF SEEDS OF BASIC, C1, C2, S1 AND S2 CATEGORIES IS NOT AUTHORIZED", which will be included in the search of registered cultivars, available to the public at the time of granting this type of registration.

Considering that the alterations raised some doubts among several users of the System, ABRASEM organized a Workshop on the theme, on February 14th, 2019, in São Paulo, with the participation of Dr. Virginia Arantes Ferreira Carpi., Coordinator of Seeds and Seedlings of MAPA / DFIA.

At the opportunity, more than 70 participants, including representatives of companies and entities associated with ABRASEM, had the opportunity to understand more about the regulation, ask questions about its application and interact with the representative of the Ministry of Agriculture.

Dr. Virginia Carpi declared "this interaction of the Ministry with ABRASEM is extremely important, considering that the contributions of the entity and its Associates, always based on technical knowledge, contribute to the regulatory work of MAPA".

Asta Vegetable & Flowers Seed Convention. Orlando / USA.

ABRASEM, represented by Dr. Paulo Campante, and the Department of Plant Health of the Ministry of Agriculture (DSV / MAPA), represented by Dr. Juliana Ribeiro and Dr. Eduardo Magalhães, attended the ASTA's 58th Vegetable & Flower Seed Conference, from February 1st to 5th 2019, in Orlando / USA, invited by the American Seed Trade Association — ASTA. It is one of the most important events in the vegetable and flower sector, with the significant participation of foreign companies and more than 800 participants.

During the event, ABRASEM and DSV / MAPA were invited to attend the workshop sponsored by USDA / APHIS and ASTA to approach the Regulatory Framework for Seed Health Initiative (ReFreSH) program, and later also participated in the ASTA Plant Health Committee meeting., with the objective of presenting the collaboratively developed work for the implementation of ISPM 38 on International Seed Movement (ISMP 38) in Brazil.

Also during these days, ABRASEM, ASTA, MAPA and APHIS held a meeting to establish concrete actions to address issues such as seed movement between the two countries, small lots sampling and the implementation of a pilot project, aiming at the implementation of the ReFreSH program in Brazil.

First Meeting of the ABRASEM's Executives Committee in 2019. Brasília / DF.

On February 19th, 2019, in Brasília / DF, the first meeting of the year from ABRASEM System Executive Committee was held. The agenda included important topics for the seed industry, such as: discussion of ABRASEM's priority scheduled for 2019; progress of the national campaign against piracy; disposal of treated seed packages; update on discussions concerning the new PVP law; soybean planting calendar, among others. The meeting was attended by members of the committee: Maria Selma (APSEMG), Valmir Pavesi (APROSESC), Ivanir Maia (APROSEM), Andréia Bernabé (APROSMAT), Rafael Lozovey (AGROSEM), Antonio Eduardo Loureiro da Silva (APASSUL), Sandra Ferreira (ANPROSEM), Marcos Roveri (UNIPASTO), Paulo Campante (Executive Superintendent of ABRASEM) and José Américo (Executive President of ABRASEM). Also present at the meeting were the President of ABRASEM's Board of Directors, Claudio Manuel da Silva, the President of APROSMAT, Gutemberg Silveira, the President of BRASPOV, Odilio Balbinotti Filho and the President of UNIPASTO, Pierre Patriat.

IP LATAM WG Meeting — Brazil. São Paulo / SP.

On February 20th and 21st, 2019, a meeting of the Working Group on Intellectual Property — LATAM was held in São Paulo / SP. During the two-day meeting, seed and biotechnology industry experts met to discuss intellectual property and regulatory issues. On the agenda, important topics for the industry include: PVP Law (LPC), Patents, Access and Benefit Sharing (ABS) and Plant Breeding Innovation.

The meeting was attended by representatives of different companies and entities of the seed chain: Alexandre Novachi (AGROBIO), Eliane Kay (AGROBIO), Fernanda Rocha (AGROBIO), Marc Cool (CORTEVA), Jean Donnenwirth (CORTEVA), Stefani Navarro (CORTEVA), Patricia Fukuma (AGROBIO), Paulo Campante (ABRASEM / BRASPOV), Angela Ferrari (BAYER), Edson Souza (BAYER), Geraldo Berger (BAYER), Carolina Lanza (BASF), Fernanda Rocha (AGROBIO), Rodrigo Lima (AGROICONE), Daniela Rodrigues (SYNGENTA), Adriana Brondani (CIB) and Dominic Muydermans (Croplife International).

Ms. Eliane Kay opened the meeting by briefing the current political situation in the country. According to her, there is still a very undefined scenario in matters related to intellectual property. Ms. Patrícia Fukuma presented an overview of the actions and discussions regarding patent law in Brazil. Mr. Paulo Campante presented the history of the discussions regarding the proposed amendments to the Cultivation Protection Law in Brazil, with emphasis on Bill 827/15. Mr. Marc Cool showed an overview of PBI and the theme of the regulatory status in different countries. Other important topics such as ABS and communication were discussed on the second day with experts from each area.

ISF Technical Committees and Executive Meetings Zurich — Switzerland.

From the 24th to 28th February in Zurich, the ISF March Meetings from the technical and executives committees members of the International Seed Federation (ISF) were held.

Among the committees that are assembled, we highlight those of Plant Breeding Innovation (PBI), Intellectual Property, Plant Health and the Executive of Associations. Representatives from 50 countries attended the meetings.

The purpose of these meetings was to update members on the work done by the committees, their future agendas, and to gather suggestions for the meetings and presentations that took place during the World Seed Congress held from June 3rd to June 5th in Nice – France.

ABRASEM was represented by the Executive President, Mr. José Américo and the member of the Board of directors, Mr. Christian Pflug.



SDA / MAPA Seminar On Good Manufacturing Practices and Self-Control in the Productive Sector. Brasília / DF.

On February 21st, 2019, the Department of Agricultural Defense from the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Supply coordinated, in Brasília / DF, the SDA / MAPA Seminar on Good Manufacturing Practices and Self-Control in the Productive Sector. During the event, actions and initiatives were discussed aimed at strengthening the use of self-control tools and good manufacturing practices in the activities regulated by the Department of Agricultural Defence from MAPA. The theme is an old claim of several productive chains besides Associations and representative Entities connected to the Agro sector.

The meeting was attended by representatives of the Ministry of Agriculture, including the Agriculture, Livestock and Supply Minister, Tereza Cristina, and the Secretary of Agricultural Defense, José Guilherme Tollstadius Leal; the Inter-American Institute for Cooperation on Agriculture — IICA, the National Consumer Secretariat / MJ and the Brazil's Federal Revenue Office; as well as representatives of associations related to the agricultural sector, such as CNA, OCB, CNI, ABRASEM, BRASPOV, APROSOJA, ABRAPA, SINDIRAÇÕES, among others.

The main referral, as a result of this meeting, was the creation of the Technical Committee of Self-Control Programs, through Ordinance nº 24, of SDA / MAPA. The purpose of the committee is to promote the articulation of public and private agencies and entities to implement self-control programs to be applied in establishments regulated by the country's agricultural defense legislation.

The New President of Apasem. Curitiba / PR.

The Paraná Association of Seed and Seedling Producers (APASEM), has a new president since March 12th. At an Assembly, the institution's members elected the agronomist and president of the Coprossel Cooperative, Paulo Pinto de Oliveira Filho.

The new representative of the Association, who has worked in the sector for over 30 years and was also part of APASEM's last management (2017/2019), is 64 years old and replaces Josef Pfann Filho who was ahead of the institution between 2017 and 2019. At the same meeting were also elected the new directors who will represent the institution for the next two years (2019/2021).

In his inaugural speech, Paulo Pinto emphasized that APASEM represents a primordial sector of the economy and for this reason "it is necessary to work to defend the good seed, the legal seed, in compliance with the laws in force in Brazil," he said.

The new representative reinforced his commitment to continue working to combat seed piracy, a subject that gained visibility in the last administration, after a campaign, held in Paraná, eventually gained national visibility and today is headed by ABRASEM in partnership with other institutions that represent the seed sector in the states. "These are activities that we need to continue to do, always with a new perspective, bringing not only the 'harms of piracy, but also the importance and value of a quality seed".


ABRASEM Legislation Committee Meeting - Brasília / DF.






1. National Seed Associations Meeting






